COMPETITION DETAILS

The competition format for 2019 will be a multiple choice question format. There will be two separate divisions – Year 11 and Year 12.

The papers will consist of 40 multiple choice questions based on unseen stimulus material. The test will be unitised with students having to complete two units, one on syllabus core and another on general economics.

Schools will need to register for the Competition at www.qeta.com.au which is the only way to register. Only schools which have registered via the QETA website will receive the actual test papers. QETA will provide the test via email to teachers. Schools will need to copy sufficient test papers for their participating students.

Students will answer the test on a student response sheet and the teacher will forward these to QETA for grading.

After grading, prizes will be awarded to all students gaining the three highest scores in each year level.

PRIZES: For each division:

First Place \$150

Second Place \$100

Third Prize \$50

- All participants to receive a professionally prepared and printed full colour certificate.
- Entries will be graded as Participant, Credit, Distinction, High Distinction.

The necessary number of correct questions to achieve C, D and HD will be indicated on the test paper.
